BRADLEY NARROWS GAP IN IOWA CAUCUS POLL

Sixth "Iowa Project 2000" survey shows Bill Bradley gaining ground on Vice President

Alexandria, Va – Pre-caucus support for Vice President Al Gore continues to soften among likely Iowa Democrat presidential caucus attendees. That, according to an independent survey conducted by PSI of Alexandria, Virginia, released tonight by Capital Communications on television stations {WOI - Des Moines, Iowa}, {KCAU - Sioux City, Iowa}, {WHBF - Rock Island, Illinois} and {KLKN - Lincoln, Nebraska}.

This is the sixth survey of "The Iowa Project 2000", conducted by PSI, which will periodically survey likely Democrat and Republican caucus attendees prior to the January 24, 2000, Iowa Presidential Caucuses. This is the third and final survey of likely Democrat caucus attendees.

"Vice President Al Gore's 28 point lead (11/9/99 Survey) over former New Jersey Senator Bill Bradley has now dropped to just over 13 points." said PSI president and project director Craig Tufty. "Bradley now leads Gore among males and likely Democrat caucus attendees ages 18-34. Although still trailing Gore, Bradley has managed to reduce Gore's lead in the age groups 35-50 and 65 and above. Gore's support among the age group 51-64 has increased and continues to remain strong. Among likely female caucus attendees, Gore's lead over Bradley has dropped by 10 points. Bradley now leads among males for the first time in the survey project 33% to 26%. The 11/9/99 survey had Gore leading Bradley among males 41% to 27%. Self-identified Catholic support of Gore continues to deteriorate, dropping 6 points from the 11/9/99 survey."

"Although still behind in almost every major demographic group except males and specific age ranges, Bill Bradley showed significant signs of increasing strength among likely Democrat caucus attendees. He has managed to reduce Gore's initial 39 point lead (6/6/99 Survey) to only 13 points in this survey."

"Democrats surveyed who indicated that they were "very sure" and "somewhat sure" that they would attend their caucuses support Gore over Bradley 57% to 43%."

"Education, health care and social security are among issues facing the country today that likely caucus attendees want the Democratic presidential candidates to talk about. The most important personal characteristics that likely caucus attendees look for in a Democratic presidential candidate still continue to be honesty, integrity and trust."

The PSI survey of 300 likely Democrat caucus attendees, conducted on 1/3-4/2000, showed the Democrat candidates standing as follows:

Mission Statement:

The mission of "The Iowa Project 2000" is to track the progress of the Republican and Democratic presidential candidates prior to the Iowa Caucuses on 1/24/2000. This will be accomplished by conducting a series of surveys over the course of 1999 and January of the year 2000. Only those individuals who indicate that they plan on attending the Iowa Caucuses on 1/24/2000 will be surveyed.

Sample Design:

The sample for this survey was drawn from a computer database maintained by the state voter registrar, of all registered Democratic voters in the state of Iowa. Each registered Democrat who had voted in the 1996 or 1998 general election had an equal opportunity of being selected to participate in this survey. Only registered Democrats were called for this survey.

3063 random phone contacts were made in order to obtain the final sample of 300. (A screening question eliminated potential respondents who indicated that they did not plan to attend their precinct caucuses on January 24, 2000).

Only the respondents who were the listed registered voters and resided at the listed addresses were interviewed.

The primary data for this survey was obtained through 300 **complete**, 5-7 minute telephone interviews. The primary data was collected on January 3-4, 2000. The results of this survey are based on the answers of all the respondents interviewed.

This survey has a margin of error of + or - 5.45 % with a 95% degree of confidence.
